The following requirements shall apply to all permits:

1. All projects shall conform to the **Minimum Standards** expressed in the **Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook, Chapter 3**, unless a variance has been granted in writing by this locality.
2. The permit must be kept on the work site and shown when requested.
3. The Town must be notified when work commences and when the project is completed.
4. Other work (grading, excavating, construction) on the project shall not commence until the sediment controls are in place as specified on the plan.
5. Applicant agrees to be responsible for any and all damages to any other installations already in place as a result of work covered by this permit.
6. Applicant agrees to maintain the work in the manner approved upon its completion.
7. A permit may be denied any applicant, and all permits issued by the Town may be revoked, whenever in the opinion of the Town Council or its designated agent, the safety, use or maintenance of the property so requires.

APPLICATION FOR LAND-DISTURBING PERMIT

I certify that I have read and understand the foregoing requirements of this application and further certify that I fully understand the provisions of the Town of Abingdon Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance and Program, and that I accept responsibility for carrying out the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan for the above referenced project as approved by the Town. I also understand that the issuance of a Land-Disturbing Permit is in addition to building or other permits required by the Town and is not intended to otherwise affect the requirements for such permits.

I further grant the right-of-entry onto this property, as described above, to the designated personnel of the Town of Abingdon for the purpose of inspecting and monitoring for compliance with the aforesaid Ordinance.

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Chapter 30 of the Town of Abingdon Code requires that a Bond or Surety be approved by the Town Attorney in the amount determined by the Director of Public Works. Such Bond shall be conditioned to conform any work to approved standards, specifications and criteria as set out in the Approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan.

Final inspections of the project shall be made by the Permit Issuing Authority. The release of Bonds and Sureties is contingent upon the findings of such inspections. Release shall occur within 60 days after disturbed areas are deemed permanently stabilized by the inspector.
